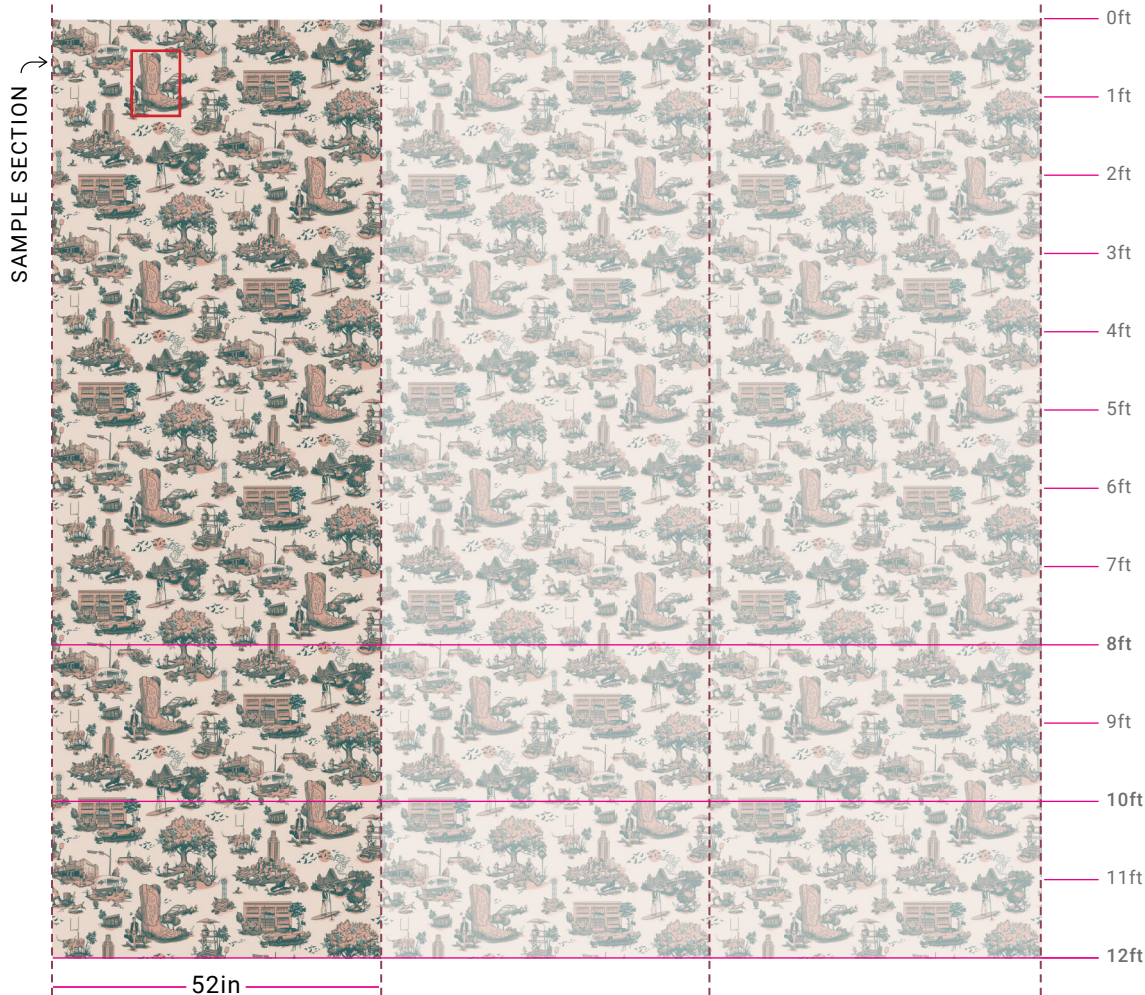

Dan followed the local “Keep Austin Weird” ethos by featuring a uniquely regional mix of bats, musicians, Wooderson, taco trailers, and Antone’s. Texas is well-represented with oversized cowboy boots, roses, UT Longhorns, and armadillos.

Harbour Island brings a lovely Caribbean vibe with a soft peach background, warm rose fill, and a deep teal green outline.

Dan Funderburgh’s witty, contemporary twist on traditional wallpaper illustrations made him the first Flavor Paper artist collaboration in 2005. We’ve been creating beautifully mischievous and irreverent wallpapers since. Dan has an uncanny ability to mash up geometric and floral patterns with classical and comical content.
