The wallpaper incorporates Matt 136's original artwork of Bay Area legends, such as rappers Too \$hort, E-40, Humpty Hump, and Mac Dre, as well as culinary icon Alice Waters, football hall of famer Joe Montana, political activist Angela Davis, and newscaster Dennis Richmond as well as classic Bay Area landmarks. "We were inspired by Mike D's 'Brooklyn Toile' wallpaper. It's a way to celebrate the Bay Area even when you no longer live there," said Lonely Islander Jorma Taccone. "Matt created a beautiful hand-drawn toile that represents what it's like to grow up in the Bay."
