



Brooklyn Bridge Wall is a photograph of a heavily used underpass in DUMBO bravely captured across several lanes of traffic.

Mostly a melange of greys and beige tones, the base colors get a bit of pop from rusty areas, a bright red tag by FADE, and a blue S tag. When printed on our durable plaster vinyl substrate, the content works in perfectly rough harmony with the texture.
