



Brooklyn Toile is a modern homage to Brooklyn in classic French toile de Jouy style, featuring scenes from Coney Island to Borough Hall to the Fulton Mall. With etchings of The Notorious B.I.G., elevated subways, pigeons, the Brooklyn Bridge, and b-boys mackin' with boomboxes, this wallpaper is the King's borough. Na' mean?

Elegant, street, and the perfect NYC bodega cookie, Black and White is an absolute classic.

Aside from occupying pride of place in Mike D's home, Brooklyn Toile has been included in MoMA: Destination NYC, acquired by the Brooklyn Museum as part of its permanent collection, and featured in the Musée de la Toile de Jouy Oberkampf bicentennial.
