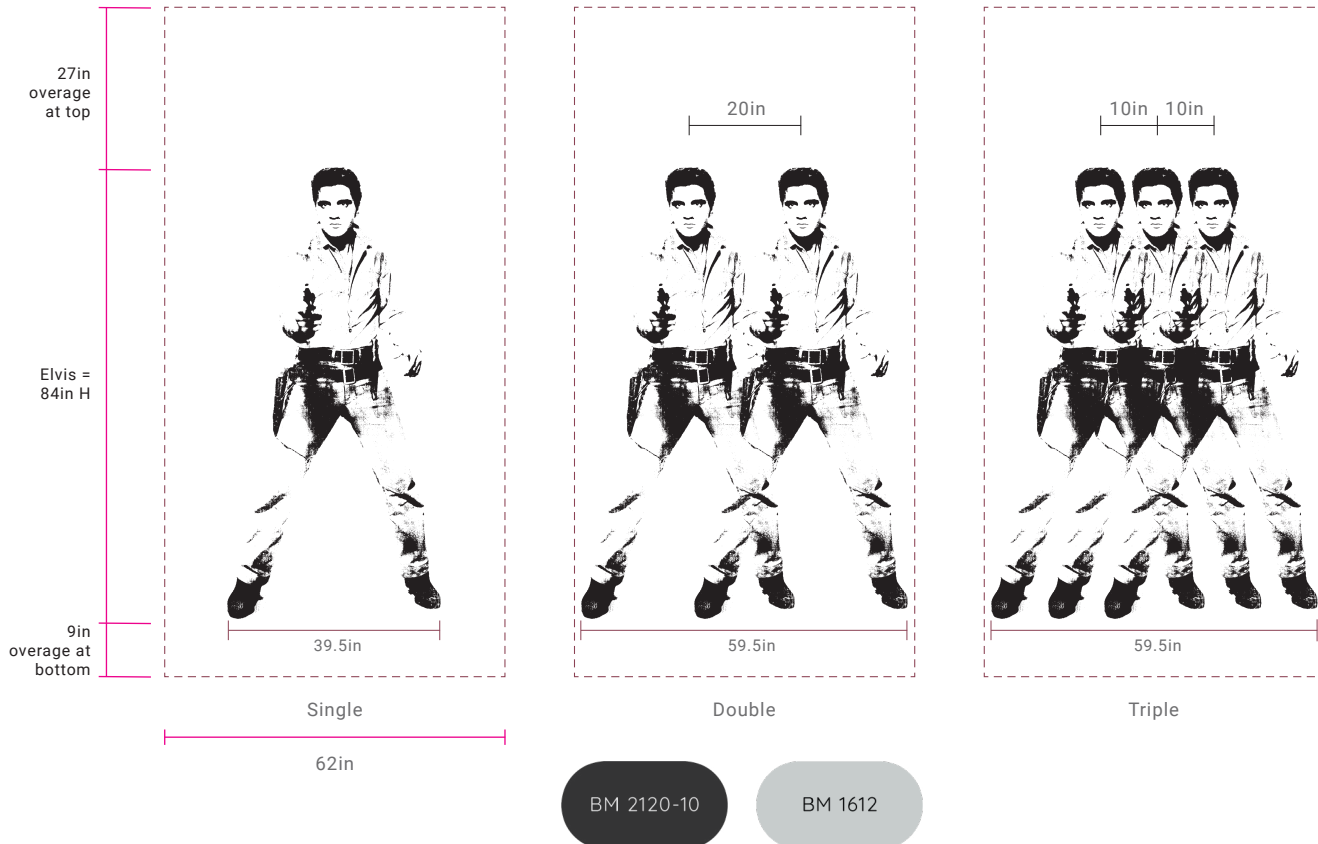

In 1963, Andy Warhol created an iconic portrayal of one of Hollywood's most celebrated stars—Elvis Presley. Warhol rolled silver paint on long rolls of canvas, then repeatedly screen-printed a monochrome image of Elvis as a gunslinger from the film *Flaming Star*.

Flavor Paper recreates this legendary piece at Warhol's original, larger-than-life scale—standing seven feet tall. Each Elvis figure is handscreened in matte black on our shimmering Silver Flash substrate and is available in single, double, or triple groupings for custom arrangements. A coordinating Silver Flash panel is also available to give you even more flexibility in layout and design.
