The delicate Tea Rose colorway features a lovely iridescent peachy pink etching printed on a linen clay coated paper. The subtlety at some angles gives way to perfect clarity at others, creating a charismatic colorway.

Dan Funderburgh's witty, contemporary twist on traditional wallpaper illustrations made him the first Flavor Paper artist collaboration in 2005. We've been creating beautifully mischievous and irreverent wallpapers since.
